

LIFE provides comprehensive, coordinated medical care and services for qualified* older adults.

LIFE is a one-stop health plan for all of their medical and social needs.

Participants agree to receive all health care services exclusively from the LIFE Program interdisciplinary team that includes the:

- Physician
- Clinic and/or homecare nurse
- Social worker
- Physical, occupational and/or speech therapies
- Recreational therapist
- Dietitian
- Certified nurse assistant
- Transportation staff

An on-call nurse, physician and social worker are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

LIFE (Living Independence for the Elderly) is provided and funded through a unique agreement with Medicare and Medicaid. VieCare Lawrence, LLC, d/b/a LIFE Lawrence County, is a partnership of Lutheran SeniorLife and Heritage Valley Health System.

LIFE is a comprehensive health plan known nationally as PACE (Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly). LIFE is not affiliated with the Pennsylvania PACE prescription drug program.

LIFE enrollees must agree to all needed health care, including primary care and specialty physician services (other than emergency services) from LIFE and its providers. Participants may be fully and personally liable for the costs of unauthorized services or those outside of the LIFE network.

Enrollment in LIFE is voluntary and you may disenroll at any time.










Live LIFE... At Home

LIFE (Living Independence for the Elderly) offers comprehensive medical care, adult day services and homecare to help participants live at home.







Because the care is personalized, the LIFE Program team members get to know the participant and can recognize even subtle changes that may require treatment plan modifications.

LIFE may provide the following services:

- Transportation to and from the LIFE center and to and from medical appointments
- Adult day services
- Primary medical and specialty care
- Home care, housekeeping and laundry
- Recreational programs
- Physical, occupational and speech therapies
- Social Services
- Meals and assistance with meal preparation
- Prescription drug coverage and medication management, including home delivery
- Nutritional counseling
- Medical equipment such as wheelchairs and walkers, and supplies
- Diabetic testing supplies and incontinence supplies
- Equipment for safety in the home
- Contracted professional services dentistry, optometry and audiology

LIFE serves individuals regardless of race, age, color, creed, religion, sex, national origin or ancestory, sexual orientation, mental or physical disability, or source of payment.

Eligibility and Cost

A person is eligible for LIFE if he or she is. . .

- 55 years of age or older
- Having difficulty managing his or her own health–related needs independently at home and meets a level of care determined by the Lawrence County Area Agency on Aging
- Living in Lawrence County
- Able to live safely at home with LIFE services

What you pay for LIFE depends on your financial situation.

- If you have Medicaid, you won't pay a monthly premium for the long-term care portion of the LIFE benefit.
- If you don't qualify for Medicaid but you have Medicare, you'll be charged a monthly premium to cover the long-term care portion of the LIFE benefit and a premium for Medicare Part D drugs.
- There's no deductible or copayment for any drug, service, or care approved by your health care team.
- If you don't have Medicare or Medicaid, you can pay for LIFE privately.
