

Thank for considering volunteering here at Passavant Community. We appreciate the possibility of serving together and your help in providing an *Abundant Life*® to our residents. Below is a list of current openings.

### Nursing Community Life (Activities)

**Come and Listen**—read stories to residents either 1:1 or in a small group. Times flexible.

**Pianist/Organist/Instrumentalists**—Provide music on organ or piano for residents who just enjoy listening to music in their household. Days and times flexible.

**One-On-One Visits**—Visitors for residents are always welcome. Visit, play games, read poetry, do puzzles, escort to destinations in the main building or outside during nice weather. Visit at times best for volunteer and resident; befriend one or more residents. Prefer weekly visits.

**Memory Care Evening Activity Leader**—Provide memory care residents with a variety of activities any evening from 7 to 8 p.m.

**Small Group Activity Leader**—Lead activities such as board games, baking, crafts, jewelry making, discussion groups, poetry or book groups, or active games such as Wii bowling or noodle ball. Days and times flexible.

**Hymn Sing/Sing-along Accompanist (piano or organ)** - Accompany residents as they sing from song sheets. Music provided.

**Poetry Group**—Lead a small group of residents with reading and discussing poetry. Staff will assist with materials. Monday through Friday between 10 and 11 a.m. or 1 to 4 p.m. is best. Weekly or twice a month.

**Manicures**—provide our ladies with hand massage with lotion and nail polish. No cutting required.

**Chapel Escorts**—Assist residents to and/or from worship service on Sunday from 9:45 to 10:30 a.m. and/or 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

**Small Group Game Leader**—Lead trivia or help residents with board games. Saturday from 10:30 to 11:30 a.m.

**Montessori Activities Assistant**—Assist memory care nursing residents with Montessori-based activities. Days and times are flexible, and training is provided.

**Household Helper and Visitor**—Help residents by replenishing their water pitchers in their rooms and visit. Wednesday and Saturday are best at 11 a.m., 12:30 and 1 p.m.

### Personal Care Community Life (Activities)

**Pianist**—Play for humn sings or singalongs or just to entertain. Tuesday, Wednesday or Friday at 2 p.m.

**Reminisce Group**—Using supplied materials to help stimulate minds and conversation, lead a group of residents as they talk about “the good old days.” Friday at 10 a.m.

## Newhaven Court Community Life (Activities)

**One-On-One Visits**—visit at times best for volunteer and resident. Befriend one or more residents. Prefer weekly or twice a month visits.

**Eagle Eye**—Support residents who have vision challenges by assisting them with various tasks such as letter writing, reading mail, selecting greeting cards from local shop or assisting with walks outdoors all while providing companionship. Days and times are flexible and can be determined by volunteer and residents. Suggest once a week visits, and not past 7 p.m.

**Evening Activities Assistant**—Lead an activity or game Monday, Tuesday or Thursday evening at 6:30 p.m.

**Friday Movie Night**—Pick a movie from our large collection (or bring one!), serve a snack. Begin at 6:30 p.m. and stay until end of the movie or leave after snack is distributed.

**Wii Bowling**—Provide guidance with the game while enjoying social interaction with personal care residents. Weekly, monthly or twice a month on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday at 6:30 p.m.

**Craft Facilitator or Assistant**—lead or assist in leading a small group of residents making crafts. Supplies provided. Patterns and ideas can be provided. Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday at 1:30 p.m., once a month. If the volunteer would like to be involved weekly, can assist with other activities.

**Bingo Caller**—Assist residents with calling the numbers and passing out prizes. Saturday at 2 p.m. Third Saturday of the month is not available.

**Pianist**—Sing-alongs or hymn sings. First Monday of the month at 3 p.m. Day can be flexible if needed.

**Activities Assistance**—Assist during the day with set-up and serving for wine & cheese party, birthday party, bingo and cake, socials, Mother's Day, Halloween, Easter, etc. Afternoons usually Monday, Tuesday or occasionally on Thursday.

## Chaplaincy

**Care Friends**—Social visit may combine some devotional elements if both the resident and volunteer are comfortable with that. Training provided through an easy-to-read manual in your own home. Buddy system is available for that first visit with residents. Visit times and days are flexible.

## Community Life

**Program Presentations**—have an idea, travel log or hobby you would like to present? Times flexible.

## Dining Services

**Front Door Delivery**—Deliver meals during evening meal time to Independent Living residents who cannot come to the main dining room due to illness or injury. Driver's license and clearance needed. Must be over 18. Wednesday, Friday and Saturday 4:30 to 5:30 p.m., Saturday from 4:30 to 5:30 p.m. and Sunday 11:30a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

**Musicians**—Provide dinner music for residents and visitors in the Baron's Inn. Intermediate to advanced musicianship required. Any Monday through Saturday from 4:30 to 8 p.m.

## Other

**Gift Shop Clerks**—Clerks provide a friendly atmosphere for shoppers, make sales using cash register, make change, assist patrons, and fill out paperwork as needed. Available shifts are Monday, Tuesday and alternate Fridays from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.; Monday or Friday from 1 to 4 p.m.; alternate Sundays from 12 to 4 p.m. Substitutes also needed. Must be 16 or older.

**Gently Used Shop**—Shop helpers provide customer service, assist with sorting donations, and assist with storing and displaying items. Wednesday from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Substitutes for any Monday through Thursday to assist with shop or donation sorting.

## Off-Site

**Collections**—Collect prizes for Bingo games. List is available through the Outreach Office including yarn, magazines (Reader's Digest, Guideposts, Family Circle), and more.
